I think most Christians have a sincere desire to be useful to the Master. The Bible teaches that God wants to use every one of us in wonderful and significant ways. But many believers often wonder, "Why doesn't God seem to use me?"

How do you become useful to God and see Him use your life for His glory?

There are several parts to answering this question, but I'll share the very first thing you need to do to become useful to God:

Make up your mind to be a vessel of honor.

Second Timothy 2:20–21 says, "Now in a large house there are not only gold and silver vessels, but also vessels of wood and of earthenware, and some to honor and some to dishonor. Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from these things, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work."

You need to make up your mind to be an honorable vessel. That means cleansing yourself from dishonorable activities.

You've got to look soberly at your life and say, "Are there things I'm doing, saying, or thinking that I know are not pleasing to God?"

He's the King of kings and Lord of lords. He is to be the Master of every area and every door of your life—your work life, your social life, your public life, and your private life. So, turn over the keys to every lock and every door. You'll never be a vessel for honor if you hang the "do not disturb" sign on some areas of your life. Everything must be laid at His feet.

Q: There are sins I can't seem to break free from, even though I want to. What can I do?

A: The key to victory is to know and embrace the truth. The sin that is pulling at you is not your friend, but your worst enemy. The more you train your mind to magnify the tremendous cost of sin, the less pleasurable it will seem. Ice cream tastes great, but if you know you are lactose intolerant, the certain pain outweighs the temporary pleasure. Additionally, the strength to overcome is not in *your* willpower, but it is in *His* divine power. As you yield yourself to the indwelling Holy Spirit and let Him lead you, He gives you the ability to rise above the temptation.

Q: The Christian life seems hard to live out. How can I do it?


