Why do we give gifts at Christmas?

1. We give gifts because God gave to us.

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. John 3:16

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

- 2. We give gifts because the wise men gave to Jesus.
 - A. They <u>recognized</u> Him for <u>who He is</u>.
 - B. They worshiped Him with their very best.
 - 1. True worship requires the giving of <u>self</u>.
 ... but they first gave themselves to the Lord and to us by
 the will of God. 2 Corinthians 8:5 CEV
 - 2. True worship requires the giving of wealth.
