

A MAN CALLED NOAH

Genesis 6:5-14 Jeff Schreve

And Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and became the father of a son. Now he called his name Noah, saying, "This one shall give us rest from our work and from the toil of our hands arising from the ground which the LORD has cursed." Genesis 5:28-29

What key lessons do we learn from the life of Noah?

1. A godly family makes a great difference.

A. As parents, our top priority is the salvation of our children.

B. As parents, our most effective witness is a godly example.

2. God extends grace in the midst of pending judgment.

But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. Genesis 6:8 KJV

A. Grace is the only way anyone can come to God.

B. Grace cannot be earned or deserved.

Through Him (Jesus) we received grace ... Romans 1:5 ISV

3. Faith in God's grace is what changes a person's life.

Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his time. Noah walked with God. Genesis 6:9

A. You are made righteous by faith apart from works.

B. Genuine faith is evidenced by a walk with God.

C. Genuine faith is evidenced by obedience to God.

Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did. Genesis 6:2
