And God looked on the earth, and behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way upon the earth. Then God said to Noah, "The end of all flesh has come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence because of them; and behold, I am about to destroy them with the earth." Genesis 6:11-12

Why does judgment come?

1. Judgment comes because people willfully reject God.

A. They refuse to listen to Him.

B. They refuse to glorify Him.

For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God, or give thanks; but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Romans 1:21

C. They are without excuse.

2. Judgment comes because people readily embrace a lie.

A. They become fools.

B. They become idolaters.

3. Judgment comes because people heartily pursue sin.

Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their heart to impurity, that their bodies might be dishonored among them. Romans 1:24

A. They become sexually promiscuous and perverted.

1. According to God, adultery and fornication are sin.

Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled; for fornicators and adulterers God will judge. Hebrews 13:4

2. According to God, homosexuality is sin.

*Men, you must not have sexual relations with another man as with a woman. That is a terrible sin!
Leviticus 18:22 ERV*
