Did you know that we can follow in the footsteps of the Magi?

1. We can seek the King.

"I see him, but not now; I behold him, but not near; a star shall come forth from Jacob, And a scepter shall rise from Israel" Numbers 24:17

A. Seeking the King is not a quick, half-hearted pursuit.

B. Seeking the King is a serious, continual, costly pursuit.

2. We can find the King.

And the star, which they had seen in the east, went on before them until it came and stood over the place where the Child was. Matthew 2:9

A. We find the King in a place of humility.

B. We find the King and experience great joy.

3. We can honor the King.

And they came into the house and saw the Child with Mary His mother; and they fell down and worshiped Him; and opening their treasures they presented to Him gifts of gold and frankincense and myrrh. Matthew 2:11

A. We honor Him with our worship and surrender.

B. We honor Him with our tangible gifts of sacrifice.
