What is the real job assignment of a parent?

1. Work on <u>you</u>: develop a <u>love relationship</u> with the LORD. "And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." Deuteronomy 6:5

A. When you love Him, you <u>fulfill the greatest commandment</u>. "This is the great and foremost commandment." Matthew 22:38

B. When you love Him, you fear and obey the greatest King. ... so that you and your son and your grandson might fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments, which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged. Deuteronomy 6:2

2. Work on your kids: teach them the ways and Word of God.

- A. Teach them <u>all the time</u>.
- B. Teach them <u>with integrity</u>, not hypocrisy. *As a parent, be the person you want your children to be.*
- C. Teach them <u>with love, not legalism</u>. *"This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far away from Me. But in vain do they worship Me." Matthew* 15:8-9
- D. Teach them with the joy of the Lord. The joy of the LORD is your strength. Nehemiah 8:10

Your job as a parent is to pass the baton of genuine faith.
