### Do you understand your way when it comes to money?

- 1. The *popular* sanguine is very <u>free</u> with money.
  - A. Sanguines enjoy spending money and buying nice things.
  - B. Sanguines are faithful to give but can be unwise in giving.
  - C. Sanguines are helped by the following prescription:
    - 1. Consult God on all spending.
    - 2. Learn to wait on the Lord.
    - 3. Become financially <u>accountable</u>.

### 2. The *powerful* choleric is very <u>driven</u> with money.

- A. Cholerics enjoy <u>making money</u> and using it <u>practically</u>.
- B. Cholerics can struggle with giving and greed.
- C. Cholerics are helped by the following prescription:
  - 1. Walk in love and value people over goals.

- 2. Be <u>patient</u> and <u>humble</u> and avoid <u>risky business deals</u>.
- 3. Involve your spouse in financial dealings and decisions.
- 4. Set your mind and heart on eternal values.

# 3. The *perfect* melancholy is very <u>controlled</u> with money.

- A. Melancholies enjoy making a budget and sticking to it.
- B. Melancholies struggle with fear and analysis paralysis.
- C. Melancholies are helped by the following prescription:
  - 1. Trust God and walk in <u>faith</u> not <u>fear</u>.
  - 2. Combat negativism with <u>praise</u> and <u>disciplined thinking</u>.
  - 3. Reevaluate your standards.

# 4. The *peaceful* Phlegmatic is very <u>cautious</u> with money.

- A. Phlegmatics love to <u>save</u> and hate to <u>spend</u>.
- B. Phelgmatics are <u>very slow</u> in making financial decisions.
- C. Phlegmatics are helped by the following prescription:
  - 1. Believe God for big things and step out in faith.
  - 2. <u>Confront</u> life and <u>discuss finances</u> with your spouse.
  - 3. Practice generosity and become a cheerful giver.
