- A. You no longer have to live with guilt and shame.
- B. You no longer have to live <u>trying to earn God's acceptance</u>. ... to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. Ephesians 1:6 NKJV
- C. You no longer have to live without power and purpose.
