## What are the lessons we can learn from the story of Ruth?

- 1. Even when we are faithless, God remains faithful.
  - A. Be <u>honest</u> with your hurts, fears, and frustrations.
  - B. Be <u>reverent</u> with your hurts, fears, and frustrations.
  - C. Be <u>obedient</u> with your hurts, fears, and frustrations.

- 2. Even when we are blessed, God has more in store.
  - A. Don't settle for the <u>leftovers</u>.

- 3. Even when things <u>look hopeless</u>, God <u>is the God of hope</u>.
  - A. He does His greatest work in the darkest circumstances.
  - B. He showers His <u>love and grace</u> on those who <u>trust Him</u>. "No Ammonite or Moabite shall enter the assembly of the LORD; none of their descendants, even to the tenth generation, shall ever enter the assembly of the LORD." Deuteronomy 23::3
