WHAT TO DO IN THE MIDST OF A STORM

Mark 4:35-41 Jeff Schreve

And there arose a fierce gale of wind, and the waves were breaking over the boat so much that the boat was already filling up. And He Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" Mark 4:37-38

What are we to do when the storms are severe?

1. We are to remember His promises.

Let us go over to the other side. Mark 4:35

He gave orders to depart to the other side. Matthew 8:18

*** You can trust the promises of God.**

"Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised; not one word has failed of all His good promise, which He promised through Moses His servant." 1 Kings 8:56

2. We are to remember His presence.

*** Your troubles cannot drown you if Jesus is in your boat.**

Cease striving [relax] and know that I am God. Psalm 46:10

3. We are to remember His passion.

*** God cares so much for you.**

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your anxiety upon Him, because He cares for you. 1 Peter 5:6-7

4. We are to remember His power.

*** God is more than able in the worst of storms.**

In your storm, will you choose to trust Him?
