<u>Sinners in the Hands of a compassionate god</u>

"For the LORD your God is a compassionate God."

Deuteronomy 4:31

And when He went ashore, He saw a great multitude, and He felt compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd Mark 6:34

Have you considered the compassionate God?

1. The compassionate God welcomes sinners.

But the multitudes were aware of this and followed Him; and welcoming them, He began speaking to them about the kingdom of God and curing those who had need of healing. Luke 9:11

* The Lord has open arms for you.

2. The compassionate God <u>teaches</u> sinners.

... and He began to teach them many things. Mark 6:34

Good and upright is the LORD; therefore He instructs sinners in the way. Psalm 25:8

* We are in desperate need of <u>His teaching</u>.

"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you." John 14:26

3. The compassionate God <u>heals</u> sinners.

And when He went ashore, He saw a great multitude, and felt compassion for them, and healed their sick. Matthew 14:14

* The Lord has told us that <u>He is our healer</u>.

"For I, the LORD, am your healer." Exodus 15:26

4. The compassionate God meets the needs of sinners.

1. The need does not have to be grave to be important to Him.

- 2. The supply does not have to be <u>much</u> to be <u>used</u> by Him.
- 5. The compassionate God satisfies sinners.
 - 1. Jesus can satisfy the <u>longings of your heart</u>.
 - 2. Jesus is the God of more than enough.

If you respond correctly to the <u>compassion</u> of God, you won't ever experience the <u>wrath</u> of God.
