- 1. There is no middle ground when it comes to Jesus.
 - "He who is not with Me is against Me; and he who does not gather with Me scatters." Matthew 12:30
- 2. There is no Christ-honoring act too small for God to reward.
- 3. There is a heavy price to pay for leading Christians astray.
 - Our example is always on display.
- 4. There is no place for a compromising attitude toward sin.
 - A. Sin is a deadly cancer of the soul.
 - B. Sin is an inside job, making outside remedies unsuccessful.
 - C. Sin must be categorically <u>mortified</u>, not carefully <u>managed</u>. Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. Galatians 5:24
 - D. Sin requires repentance in order to be saved from hell.
- 5. There is a clear call to be a salty Christian.

"Salt is good; but if the salt becomes unsalty, with what will you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with one another." Mark 9:50
