

WHO IS THIS MAN?

FAITH LIKE A CHILD

Mark 10:13-16 Jeff Schreve

"Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it at all." Mark 10:15

What does it mean to receive the kingdom of God like a child?

1. A child is humble and lowly.

But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE." James 4:6

But to this one I will look, to him who is humble and contrite of spirit, and who trembles at My Word. Isaiah 66:2

2. A child is helpless and dependent.

"O our God, will You not judge them? For we are powerless before this great multitude who are coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are on You." 2 Chronicles 20:12

- Grace + Faith + Nothing Else = Eternal Salvation

3. A child is trusting and believing.

A. We often struggle to simply believe God.

*The other disciples therefore were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I shall see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."
John 20:25*

B. We are blessed when we simply take Him at His Word.

... yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief, but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully assured that what He had promised, He was able also to perform. Romans 4:20-21
