WHO IS THIS MAN?

THE \$64,000 QUESTION

Mark 12:35-37 Jeff Schreve

"If David called the Messiah his Lord, how can the Messiah be his son?" Mark 12:37 CEV

What was the point of Jesus' BIG question?

1. The Jews believed the Messiah was the Son of David.

"Has not the Scripture said that the Christ comes from the offspring of David and from Bethlehem, the village where David was?" John 7:42

- A. They believed the Messiah would be a great conqueror.
- B. They did not believe the Messiah would be divine.

2. The Jews believed Psalm 110 spoke of the Messiah.

"David himself said in the Holy Spirit, 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD,
"SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I PUT YOUR ENEMIES BENEATH
YOUR FEET." Mark 12:36

- A. The Jews were <u>right in this Messianic belief</u> of Psalm 110.
- B. David did not speak by mistake but by the Holy Spirit.

3. The Jews were forced to see the Messiah as God and man.

"If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his son?" No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question. Matthew 22:45-46

- A. The Messiah is the Son of David and the Son of God.
- B. People must see Jesus as the God-man to be saved.

 Unless you believe I am [He], you shall die in your sins.

 John 8:24

Is your faith firmly rooted in Jesus, the God-man?
