Mark 12:38-40

What do we see with regard to the religious hypocrites?

- 1. Religious hypocrites are among us.
 - A. Jesus tells us to be on guard against them.
 - B. Jesus wants us to be discerning. Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. 1 John 4:1

2. Religious hypocrites are in it for themselves.

- A. They live for the accolades of the people.
- B. They try to appear righteous.
- C. They prey on the poor and helpless.
- D. They will receive greater condemnation.
