Mark 14:12-26 Jeff Schreve

And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." Luke 22:15-16

What does Mark tell us about the Last Supper?

1. Jesus orchestrated the exact place.

The disciples went out and came to the city, and found it just as He had told them; and they prepared the Passover. Mark 14:16

- A. He has supernatural knowledge.
- B. He makes sure everything goes to plan.

2. Jesus declared His betrayal.

A. It was a heinous sin.

Even my close friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me. Psalm 41:9

B. It was a hypocritical sin.

And Judas, who was betraying Him, said, "Surely it is not I, Rabbi?" Jesus said to him, "You have said it yourself."

Matthew 26:25

C. It was a hellish sin.

And after the morsel, Satan then entered into him. John 12:28

3. Jesus transformed Passover into the Lord's Supper.

- A. He would be the <u>Passover lamb</u>.
- B. He would give His body and blood to deliver us.
