What do you do when your mountain won't move?

1. Check your faith.

Now faith is the assurance (title deed, confirmation) of things hoped for (divinely guaranteed), and the evidence of things not seen [the conviction of their reality—faith comprehends as fact what cannot be experienced by the physical senses]. Hebrews 11:1 AMP

- A. Is your faith <u>true</u> or <u>false</u>?
- B. Is your faith growing or diminishing?
- C. Is your faith <u>persistent</u> or <u>fragile</u>?

2. Check your connection.

A. Are you abiding in the Lord?

"I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me, and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing." John 15:5

- B. Are you growing in your prayer life?
- C. Are you growing in personal discipline?
 ... discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness. 1 Timothy 4:7

3. Check the will of God.

And this is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him. 1 John 5:14-15

- A. What has God <u>promised</u>?
- B. What does God want?

Delight yourself in the LORD; and He will give you the desires of your heart. Psalm 37:4
