Fear No Evil NAKED AND AFRAID

Genesis 3:1-24 March 5, 2017 Jeff Schreve

There are basically three types of fear:

- 1. There is a godly fear. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom. Proverbs 9:10
- 2. There is a <u>wise</u> fear. *A lion has roared! Who will not fear? Amos 3:8*
- 3. There is an <u>ungodly</u> fear.

For God has not given us a spirit of fear; but of power, and love, and of a sound mind. 2 Timothy 1:7 NKJ

What are the roots of fear?

1. Fear comes from disobeying God. Gen 2:16-17

And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you shall surely die." Genesis 2:16-17

A. Sin brings separation.

B. Separation brings fear.

2. Fear comes from feeling naked before God.

Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings. Genesis 3:7

- A. Sin causes us to become self-conscious.
- B. Sin causes us to try to <u>cover up</u>.
- C. Sin can't be covered by the fig leaves of the flesh.

3. Fear comes from <u>a warped view of</u> God.

A. God is for you, not against you.

The LORD is for me; I will not fear; What can man do to me? The LORD is for me among those who help me. Psalm 118:6-7

B. God wants to <u>forgive</u> you, not <u>condemn</u> you. For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, and abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You. Psalm 86:5

C. God wants you to <u>come to</u> Him, not <u>hide from</u> Him. "... and you are unwilling to come to Me, that you may have life." John 5:40

God is asking one critical question, "Where are you?"
