What do we learn about God and man in the light of the cross?

1. The cross reveals the true heart of God.

- A. At the cross, we see the love of God.
- B. At the cross, we see the righteousness of God. *Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne:* Lovingkindness and truth go before You. Psalm 89:14

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up." John 3:14

... for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. Romans 3:26

- C. At the cross, we see the grace of God. "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men" Titus 2:11
- D. At the cross, we see the mission of God. "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world should be saved through Him." John 3:17

2. The cross reveals the true heart of man.

A. Man is in serious trouble. "... should not perish, but have eternal life."

B. Man loves the darkness of sin.

- C. Man is at the crossroads of <u>light and darkness</u>.
 - 1. Coming to Jesus means <u>I get honest about my sin</u>.

If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. 1 John 1:8, 10

2. Coming to Jesus means I go His way, not my way.

Eternal life requires <u>a decision;</u> you cannot <u>remain neutral</u>.
