What do we learn from the two witnesses in the Tribulation?

1. They are <u>clothed with sackcloth</u>.

A. The sackcloth represents mourning and sorrow.

B. The sackcloth represents <u>repentance and contrition</u>. So I gave my attention to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes. Daniel 9:3

2. They are <u>Spirit-filled and Spirit-led</u>.

Then he answered and said to me, "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel saying, 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the LORD of hosts. Zechariah 4:6

A. Their ministry is one of power, plagues, and déjà vu.

And He was transfigured before them And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. Matthew 17:2-3

B. Their ministry is to <u>turn men to the Savior</u>. *"How long will you hesitate between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Ball follow him." 1 Kings 18:21*

3. They <u>fulfill their mission</u>.

And when they have finished their testimony Revelation 11:7

- A. The Antichrist will kill them.
- B. The people will rejoice and celebrate their deaths.
- C. The Lord will be glorified.
