What do you do when everything falls apart?

1. You run to Him immediately.

A. Come before Him with reverence.

*For the LORD most High is to be feared, a great king over all the earth.
Psalm 47:2*

B. Come before Him with confidence.

*Let us therefore draw near with confidence to the throne of grace...
Hebrews 4:16.*

2. You rejoice in Him continually.

A. You can make the choice to rejoice.

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say rejoice. Philippians 4:4

B. You must see beyond circumstances.

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today, yes and forever. Hebrews 13:8

3. You rely on Him completely.

A. The Sovereign Lord will be your strength.

Cast your burden upon the LORD, and He will sustain you. Psalm 55:22

B. The Sovereign Lord will make your way sure.

C. The Sovereign Lord will bring you to the mountain top.
