Real Christianity has Power.

1. With real Christianity, there is power to live it.

A. Almighty God lives every believer.

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you...? 1 Corinthians 6:19

B. Almighty God changes every believer.

Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover...many believed in His name, beholding the signs which He was doing. But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men, and because He did not need for anyone to bear witness concerning man for He Himself knew what was in man. John 2:23-25

2. With real Christianity, there is power to share it.

A. God calls us to be His witnesses, not lawyers.

Go home to your people and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He had mercy on you.

Mark 5:19

B. The walk must match the talk.

And they continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" Acts 2:12

3. With real Christianity, there is power to stand up for it.

A. A witness is a martyr.

B. A witness dies to pride.

If anyone wishes to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me. Luke 9:23
