### #3 DID NO ONE CONDEMN YOU?

John 8:1-11 . Jeff Schreve

What does God want to teach us about condemnation?

1. Religious people love to condemn others.

A. Religious people hate true spirituality.

*But as it is, you are seeking to kill me, a man who told you the truth, which I heard from God. John 8:40*

B. Religious people have no true compassion.

*But go and learn what this means, "I desire compassion, and not sacrifice." Matthew 9:13*

*For judgment will be merciless to the one who has shown no mercy; mercy triumphs over judgment. James 2:13*

2. Everyone is deserving of condemnation.

*He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her. John 8:7*

A. No one is without sin.

*There is none righteous, not even one. Romans 3:10*

*If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O LORD, who could stand? Psalm 130:3*

B. All of us deserve God's judgment.

*For the wages of sin is death... Romans 3:23*

3. Jesus offers us undeserved forgiveness.

*Did no one condemn you? Neither do I condemn you. John 8:10-11*

A. Jesus came to save us.

*For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. John 3:17 NIV*

*For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. Luke 9:56*

B. Jesus came to free us.

*The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives, and freedom to prisoners. Isaiah 61:1*
