#3 DID NO ONE CONDEMN YOU?

What does God want to teach us about condemnation?

1. Religious people love to condemn others.

A. Religious people hate true spirituality.

But as it is, you are seeking to kill me, a man who told you the truth, which I heard from God. John 8:40

B. Religious people have no true compassion.

But go and learn what this means, "I desire compassion, and not sacrifice." Matthew 9:13

For judgment will be merciless to the one who has shown no mercy; mercy triumphs over judgment. James 2:13

2. Everyone is deserving of condemnation.

He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her. John 8:7

A. No one is without sin.

There is none righteous, not even one. Romans 3:10

If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O LORD, who could stand? Psalm 130:3

B. All of us deserve God's judgment.

For the wages of sin is death... Romans 3:23

3. Jesus offers us <u>undeserved forgiveness</u>.

Did no one condemn you? Neither do I condemn you. John 8:10-11

A. Jesus came to save us.

For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. John 3:17 NIV

For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. Luke 9:56

B. Jesus came to free us.

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives, and freedom to prisoners. Isaiah 61:1
