How can you experience powerful answers to your prayers?

1. You must recognize Him.

And they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by.

Luke 18: 37

A. Jesus of Nazareth is the Messiah.

Say to those who are afraid, "Be strong, and do not fear, for your God is coming to destroy your enemies. He is coming to save you." And when He comes, He will open the eyes of the blind and unstop the ears of the deaf. The lame will leap like a deer, and those who cannot speak will shout and sing! Isaiah 35:4-6 NLT

B. Jesus of Nazareth can help you.

He who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him. Hebrews 11:6

2. You must cry out Him.

And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

Mark 10:47
