WHAT IS WORSHIP?

Psalm 95:1-7 Jeff Schreve

You shall fear only the LORD your God; and you shall worship Him, and swear by His name. Deuteronomy 6:13

Worship is hard to define.

Worship is not what we often think.

Worship is our loving, adoring, “all that is within me” response to the revelation of God and all that He is and does.

How can we really and truly worship God?

1. To worship God, you have to see who God is.

*For the LORD is a great God and a great King above all gods.
Psalm 95:3*

A. The LORD is a great God who can do anything.

For the LORD your God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God who does not show partiality, nor take a bribe. Deuteronomy 10:17

B. The LORD is a great King who is over everything.

For the LORD Most High is to be feared, a great King over all the earth. Psalm 47:2

2. To worship God, you have to see who God is to you.

For He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand. Psalm 95:7

A. The LORD is your God who loves us.

God is not ashamed to be called their God. Hebrews 11:16

B. The LORD is your Shepherd who cares for us.

C. The LORD is your Father who is proud to be your Dad.

This I know, that God is for me. Psalm 56:9

3. To worship God, you have to respond to Him.

A. You respond with reverence and awe.

*Worship the LORD with reverence and rejoice with
trembling. Psalm 2:11*

B. You respond with a heart filled with love and gratitude.

C. You respond with all that is within you.

*O come, let us sing for joy to the LORD; let us shout joyfully to
the rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with
thanksgiving; let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.*
