*For I am the least of the apostles, who am not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. **But by the grace of God I am what I am**, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me. 1 Corinthians 15:9-10*

How important is the grace of God?

1. You are saved by the grace of God.

But we believe that we are saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus. Acts 15:11

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace, which He lavished upon us. Ephesians 1:7-8

A. All of us are helpless sinners before a holy God.

B. All of us are not only undeserving but ill-deserving.

C. All of us have been offered unfathomable grace.

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich. 2 Corinthians 8:9

2. You are changed by the grace of God.

A. God's grace removes the guilt.

He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. Colossians 2:14 NLT

B. God's grace brings peace and security.

...to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. Ephesians 1:6

C. God's grace brings power and purpose.

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10

3. You are to be forever amazed by the grace of God.

* Never lose the wonder of God's grace.
